I understand that travel cancellation and medical emergency insurance is being offered at a group rate and is mandatory. I know that there may be rigorous walking on some of the excursions. I am aware that prices are subject to change if airlines or ground operators increase their prices or if the US dollar is devalued significantly against foreign currencies or if there is a fuel surcharge or if the group fails to get the minimum number. Pilgrimage Terms and Conditions

- 1) Your deposit of \$500.00 is refundable only if we fail to get enough participants for the pilgrimage. If we do get enough pilgrims, the deposit will be applied toward your total price.
- 2) As soon as we have enough participants, you will be notified and asked to make a payment of \$2,500.00 which will include your insurance premium. This amount is non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 3) The full amount for your pilgrimage is due 60 days prior to the departure date and is non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 4) If you need to cancel due to illness of yourself or a family member, it is your responsibility to file a claim with the insurer to recover any amount you have already paid less the insurance premium.

Additional Information

- 1) Your passport must be valid for six months beyond the scheduled end of your trip.
- 2) However, since you will need a multiple-entry visa for Jordan, your passport *should be valid for one year* beyond the date of when the visa is issued.
- 3) People, including travel agents, will tell you that you may obtain your visa upon arrival at Queen Alia Airport in Amman. That is true, but you cannot get a multiple-entry visa there. You will be leaving Jordan and returning to Jordan on the pilgrimage. Since it is not possible to obtain a visa at every entry point, you must have a multiple-entry visa before you leave home.
- 4) You may obtain your visa directly from the Jordanian Embassy in Washington, D.C. The visa application is available at <http://www.jordanembassyus.org/new/consular/pdf/visaapp.pdf>
- 5) If you prefer, you may arrange for Linda Silverio of Linsil Travel to obtain your visa for a fee of \$40.00 for processing and postage. This is in addition to the charge for a multiple-entry visa which is currently \$31.50.
